Mission/purpose of your organization:

Marin Athletic Foundation (MAF) was founded in 1984 by individuals concerned about the decrease in funding for athletic programs in the Marin County high schools. The organization and the community members who volunteer their time and efforts for the organization believe that athletics are a vital part of every high school experience and provide important educational and developmental outcomes for students. The organization believes that school districts need community support to keep athletic programs from being eliminated and to ensure that broad participation by all students in both interscholastic and intramural programs continue.

The mission is to support (\$) athletic programs by focusing on the health, safety, and injury prevention of all athletes in HS in Marin. We provide students, faculty, and staff with resources to create a safer athletic experience for everyone.

This program is funded by the generous giving of individual donors and grants such as this one. We typically give to the 12 local high schools around \$65,000/year pending the amount of fundraising we are able to do throughout the year. We have a Director of Operations; the only paid person on staff, mailing costs, operating costs including by not limited to: website, CRM systems, marketing and host 3 – 4 events throughout the year to honor our Hall of Fame inductees, our broader community at a golf tournament and our Outstanding Student award winners. These events raise additional funds and awareness for our cause. Like many others, due to COVID, we have had to postpone or cancel all of our gatherings since March 2020 and are attempting to be creative to find ways to raise funds/ awareness for our athletic programs. We were still able to honor our 24 Outstanding Student-Athletes via Zoom, provide scholarships to 15 students, and have continued outreach to provide equitable support for all the diverse student population of Marin. These programs are going to need our help more than ever with the added stress on the health and safety of the athletes not only with the inherent risk of all sports but the new threat of COVID. The organization's main fundraising events consist of a golf tournament held each Spring (postponed due to COVID) and a mail fundraising campaign in the Fall. Since Marin Athletic Foundation's inception, the organization has donated more than \$1 million towards high school athletic programs.

Youth Sports are the lifeblood of many communities and Marin is no exception.
