Although seriously curtailed by the Covid-19 Pandemic, the Log Cabin supports and presents many San Anselmo and Marin County organizations' activities. It serves as a Polling Place for the County. It is a facility for non-profits such as a Boy Scouts Troop, Rotary Boys and Girls baseball teams, "Toys for Tots," and Boys and Girls State programs. Normally, the annual Memorial Day BBQ is open to veterans and the total community, as is the annual Veterans Day BBQ. It serves as an ideal facility for outdoor family events and as a safe play area for children.
