**Project Summary:** The principal action considered in this SEIR is adoption and implementation of the Marin Countywide Plan (2007) with respect to the San Geronimo Valley watershed and the potential for cumulative effects on salmonids.

Marin County is the lead agency, pursuant to the State Guidelines for the California Environmental Quality Act (State CEQA Guidelines Section 15150) for the preparation of an Environmental Impact Report Supplement (SEIR). This SEIR has been prepared by Marin County in accordance with CEQA, the State of California CEQA Guidelines, and County Environmental Impact Review Guidelines. The Final SEIR finds that the project, in combination with changed conditions, would not result in any unavoidable significant impacts. All impacts in the Final SEIR were either identified to be less than significant, or able to be rendered less than significant through mitigation measures identified in the Final SEIR. **This review is not for the purpose of soliciting comments on the Amendment to the Final SEIR and no subsequent responses to comments will be provided in the Final SEIR document.**
