SUBJECT: CONDUCT A PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING REGARDING CONTINUATION OF THE RUSH CREEK LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING DISTRICT

Dear Board Members,

RECOMMENDATION:

Conduct a public information meeting and allow opportunity for questions regarding continuation of the Rush Creek Landscaping and Lighting District.

SUMMARY:

On June 13, 2017, your Board adopted a Resolution of Intention to continue maintenance and operation of the Rush Creek Landscaping and Lighting District in Novato. As required by the Streets and Highways Code, the Board must now conduct a Public Information Meeting, allowing an opportunity for the public to ask questions about the District and the \$949 annual assessment.

The Public Information Meeting represents the third step in a four step annual process to continue the Rush Creek Landscaping and Lighting District. The final step will occur on July 25, 2017, when your Board conducts a Public Protest Hearing to accept public testimony and determine whether it is appropriate to continue operation of the District.
